- Proactively engage with individuals at the end of the service/formal presentation, ensuring that individuals interested in becoming a Life changer correctly complete the relevant form

Personal qualities required

- A passionate public speaker
- Comfortable asking others to be Life changers 'from the front' and one-to-one
- Passionate about CAP's vision both locally and nationally

Experience required

- Personal involvement with CAP either as a Head Office or frontline staff member, or a local volunteer
- Past experience of preaching or speaking to church groups is helpful but not essential
